Post-operative care instructions

Night of Surgery:

- Rest your leg (operation side) on a pillow overnight
- Take paracetamol or pain relief as prescribed for pain

Following Days:

- Change bandage dressings as required or when dressings get soiled
- Keep wound dry
- Dab wound dry should it get wet
- Do not put pressure on the wound
- Do not drive until after the stitches are removed
- If sutures are used, please attend your local doctor to have them removed between day 10-14 following SURGERY.
- If absorbable sutures are used, please attend your local doctor for a wound review around 7 days following DISCHARGE.
- Make an appointment to see your surgeon in 3 weeks but you will have a telehealth review 1 week following surgery already arranged
- If you perform non-labour intensive work that does not impact on your leg or the wound, you may return to part-time modified work after the stitches have been removed
- If you perform labour intensive work, do not return to work until after you have seen your surgeon
